

DID YOU KNOW?

The Real Winnie Bear

In 1914 a Canadian veterinarian named Harry Colebourn while traveling to military training purchased a 7-month old black bear cub from a trader at a railroad stop.



The bear became a troop mascot and was named after Colebourn's adopted hometown of Winnipeg. When deployed he brought Winnie with him to England and gave her to the London Zoo for safe keeping while he was at war and promised to bring her back to Canada once the conflict was over.

When Colebourn was discharged in 1918 he returned to the zoo to collect the bear but quickly saw that her home was now in London, where she was regularly visited by children including the real life Christopher Robin.



Christopher developed a special friendship with the bear feeding her condensed milk and getting hugs! Christopher renamed his teddy bear at home "Winnie" and this inspired his father, Alan Alexander Milne, to write some of the most beloved stories of all time.
